The Edgewater Casino is Vancouver's premier downtown casino. The casino's vast waterfront location on the shores of the Plaza of Nations borders Yaletown, the city's bustling entertainment district, BC Place, and GM Place. The 290-seat venue hosts everything from pay-per-view sports events on their three 18' big screens to exclusive red carpet events.

Overall, the Edgewater Casino is a very wheelchair accessible space. They've done a great job of ensuring sufficient space to get through the casino floor, food court, smoking area, theatre and other amenities. Though not gender neutral, the washrooms all provide a wheelchair accessible option. When performing the audit, staff were friendly, helpful, and interested in learning more about accessibilities, and how they might improve - always a good sign. As well, i observed willingness to make the experience at the casino a pleasant one for people with varying access needs. There is a wheelchair/scooter lift, as well as an escalator.

The Stadium Skytrain Station is a short 2 block walk from the Casino. Edgewater offers free shuttle service to and from the Casino, Stadium SkyTrain Station and Chinatown approximately every 20 minutes. Shuttle pick-ups are at the Beatty Street entrance to the station and the corner of Keefer and Main Street. The Casino provides Complimentary Valet and there is also underground and above ground parking available. Though i did not notice bicycle lockups while auditing the space, there are ample spots to lock a bike.

Please note that there is not currently a scent-reduced policy in place at Edgewater Casino, though specific events will have their own policies.
