Five Sixty is located in the old A & B Sound location in the heart of downtown. There is live music during the week and dancing on the weekend with some of Vancouver's most innovative DJ's. This 4-floor multi-media complex has over 28000 square feet of state of the art sound, design, lighting and visual technology, and boasts 3 levels of night clubbing, 3 dance floors, 3 lounges, and is fully wheelchair accessible.

Being downtown, 560 is close to shopping, restaurants, convenience stores, banking and more. There is quick and easy access to fully wheelchair accessible transit including buses, skytrain, seabus, and the westcoast express, within less than a half block. There are no formal bike lockups, but plenty of spots for locking your bike are available in the surrounding area.

The three main floors are wheelchair accessible, including washrooms, lounge areas, bars, smoking, and refuge areas. Staff are able to assist patrons who require it. There is a lift (at the back on the left, to go to the 3rd floor) as well as an elevator (at the back on the right, to go to the basement), the former may require having staff move a couple of items first, and the latter requires staff to operate. Seating is comfortable and friendly for diverse body types, offering wider, deeper seats, some with armrests and some without. All areas of the club offer something interesting, and three full levels are accessible, and it's nice to see the access areas are integrated into the rest of the space in a way that feels really welcoming. It is a nightclub, so lighting is ambient, though there are some areas which are better lit for easier lip reading and signing.

There are wheelchair accessible gender neutral washrooms on all floors. There are ample additional gender neutral washrooms on each level. On the main floor, you may require a key for the washroom.
