The Helm, in their own words:

“The Helm is a supperclub: a celebration of food, people and atmosphere. Savour the delights of the finest and freshest Vancouver ingredients. Sip on hand-crafted cocktails and treasured wines. Get lost in the music with the sounds of hot local DJs and live Canadian musical artists.”

Located right next to Vancouver’s Davie Village, The Helm is close to shopping, cafes, and iconic English Bay.

Overall, The Helm is a really inviting space, open and cozy all at once. There is one large main area, with a variety of seating options including a cozy fireplace lounge area (up 3 steps, no ramp yet unfortunately). There’s ample patio space. All but the fireplace lounge is wheelchair accessible.

The (currently) gender-specific washrooms each offer a spacious wheelchair accessible option.

While there is no access parking nearby, there is street parking available out front, and wheelchair accessible bus lines within one block.
